Guidelines for proposals

- 1. Concentrate on the algorithmic challenges
- 2. Create figures to explain your idea, algorithm, workflow etc.
- 3. Be specific about:
 - a. the experiments you will perform and/or the data you will use
 - b. your assumptions and/or your central hypothesis
- 4. Elaborate on the testing/validation of your envisioned results
- 5. The proposal should be self-contained:
 - a. refer to other papers, but it should not be necessary to read these
 - b. describe these papers not at the algorithmic level, but summarise and focus on the basis
- 6. Read your own proposal (or have someone read it) critically, try to find the weak spots
